Bishops Vow to Fight Mandate from U.S. Department of Health & Human Services

The federal Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has issued a rule forcing nearly all private health plans to include coverage for sterilization, abortifacients and all FDA-approved prescription contraceptive drugs and devices. These are listed among "preventive services for women" that all health plans will have to cover without co-pays or other cost-sharing -- regardless of whether the insurer, the employer or other plan sponsor, or even the woman herself objects to such coverage.

The Administration has refused to recognize the Constitutional conscience rights of organizations and individuals who oppose the mandate. The exemption for "religious employers" is so narrow that it fails to cover the vast majority of faith-based organizations, including Catholic hospitals, universities, and service organizations that help millions every year.



The bishops have encouraged us to take action and to voice our concerns about this assault on religious liberty.
